We have some unique features at Olde Stone which we feel can add to the learning experience of your internship; some of those features include a 6-inch sand cap on all of the fairways, tees and approaches. All greens are equipped with the Sub-Air system. We have a 3,000+ head RainBird Irrigation system and an award winning maintenance facility.

As an intern at Olde Stone you will gain invaluable experience in managing and maintaining cool season turfgrasses in the transition zone. You will be involved in all of the aspects of golf course maintenance at Olde Stone, which include but are not limited to: seeding, fertilization, watering practices, chemical applications, irrigation repair, and the use of Sub-Air.

Olde Stone has hosted the 2008 Jr. Ryder Cup, the 2009 Kentucky Open and again in 2012 will host the NCAA Regional Golf Championship.
