The par-72, Perry Maxwell design stretches to 7,387 yards from the championship tees, boasting 18 holes of scenic splendor and a challenging test for golfers of all skill levels. Set on the eastern edge of the OU campus, we are ideally located just four miles east of I-35. Originally designed by Maxwell in 1951, the course underwent a redesign in 1996 by Robert E. Cupp. Jimmie Austin underwent an extensive renovation in preparation for the 2009 U.S. Amateur Public Links Championship and is currently the only golf course within 50 miles of the OKC metro area named one of Golfweek's "Best Courses You Can Play" (2008, 2009 and 2010).
