The course is home to the Notre Dame Men's and Women's varsity golf teams. Some accolades for the Warren Golf Course include; Golfweek's "2011 Best Campus Courses" #12, Golfweek's "2011 Best Courses You Can Play State-by-State Public-access Courses"; Indiana #5. The course is a throw-back to traditional golf course design that is highly maintained but still a little rough around the edges.

This coming season the Warren course will be hosting the 2012 U.S. Amateur Qualifier, two NCAA tournaments hosted by the Fighting Irish Men's golf team, one in spring and The Fighting Irish Gridiron Golf Classic in the fall. Along with these tournaments, other qualifiers are played here throughout the year as well as some junior tournaments. Each week we prepare the course to give the golfer the best experience possible.
