Assistant Golf Course Superintendent

Job Description:

Assists in planning and supervising the maintenance of the golf course. Carries out established policies, procedures, and rules of the golf course and its facilities. Prepares and maintains essential records and files. Prepare annual budget proposals and administer an approved budget. Participates in the recruitment, selection, supervision, and training of golf course personnel. May recommend selection of specified equipment for the maintenance and operation of the golf course. Maintains the inventory of supplies and equipment. Gives assignments and instructions to employees. May prepare and carry out of a safety program for personnel. Prepares requisitions, and receives, issues, and accounts for materials and supplies. Participates in the preparation of plans and specifications for construction improvement to the golf course. May administer the golf course in a manner that reflects sound budgetary practice, agency policy, and efficient use of assigned personnel. Ensures proper use and care of equipment, materials, and supplies. Will be required to learn to utilize various types of electronic and/or manual recording and information systems used by the agency, office, or related units. Instructs equipment operators on the operations and care of mowing and other equipment; supervises pesticide applications and/or operates and calibrates pesticide application equipment; supervises and participates in the operation and maintenance of pumps, and in the maintenance of irrigation and drainage systems. Assists in personnel management and evaluation, employee safety, personnel discipline and may also modify the daily work schedule based on professional interpretation.

The Monmouth County Park System's Golf Course operation is located in central New Jersey, the heart of horse country in the New Jersey Shore area. The operation is comprised of seven golf courses. Four of the courses are championship caliber. The Golf Course Facilities consist of a diverse variety of layouts. In the stable of Monmouth County Golf Courses, we have a "turn of the century penal design" seaside links course constructed during early 1900's, designed by Architect; Joseph "Scotty" I'Anson. Notables Mark Mungeam, Robert Trent Jones, and Francis Dwayne designed the remaining golf courses. We have hosted two National USGA Championships, a New Jersey State Amateur and numerous MET (Metropolitan Golf Association) Championships in addition to being a US Open Long Drive qualifying site. Golf Course facilities also include twenty-seven and eighteen-hole executive courses. We have recently completed the construction of Charleston Springs, a 36-hole golf course complex and Short Game Area with both links and parkland style designs. Charleston Springs is composed of two eighteen-hole Championship golf courses, and a golf academy/family learning center. The Monmouth County Park System averages 300,000 rounds of golf annually and is nationally regarded as a leader in Municipal Golf.
