Under the direction of the Director of Sports Turf and Grounds, the selected candidate will manage the day-to-day activities for the Athletics Grounds, including UCF Athletic fields and adjacent facilities. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: development and implementation of a maintenance program to address field turf maintenance of Athletics game and practice fields; managing of field preparation / painting; supervision of grounds staff; inspection of work sites and equipment ensuring compliance with University and Athletics standards; coordination of fertilization, pesticides, and chemical maintenance of appropriate areas; assisting with budget management; and oversight of safety training program related to grounds activities. May also include some game administration of sporting events.

Minimum qualifications: Bachelor's degree in an appropriate area of specialization and one (1) year appropriate experience; or high school diploma and five (5) years of appropriate experience. Must have, or be able to obtain, a Limited Lawn and Ornamental License, pesticide spraying license as governed by Florida Statutes 482 & 487. Prefer athletic turf or golf turf preparation and maintenance experience. Management experience also preferred. As a UCFAA, Inc. staff member, the selected candidate will be a person of integrity and character who shares a commitment for knowing and complying with NCAA, Conference, and institutional rules as they apply to the UCF Athletics program.
